

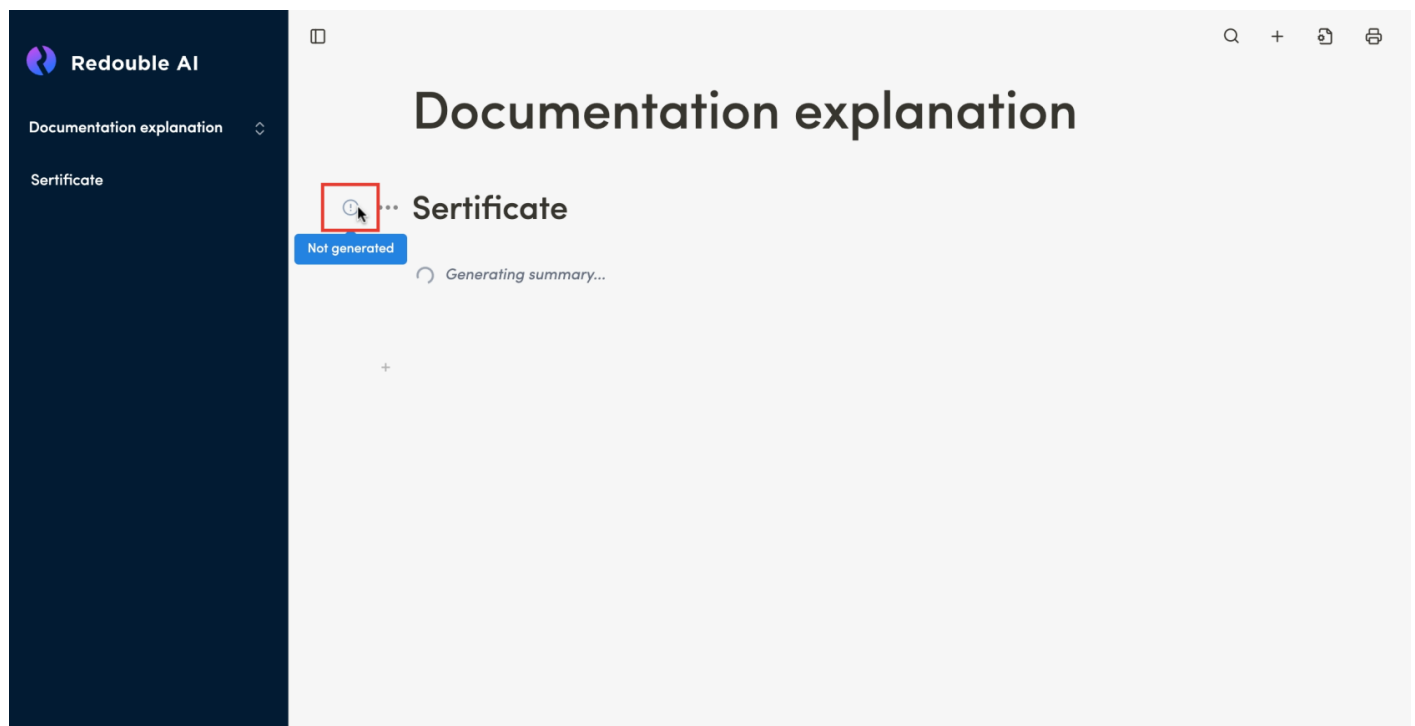
4.1 Question status indicator

Purpose: This indicator appears when a user creates a question.



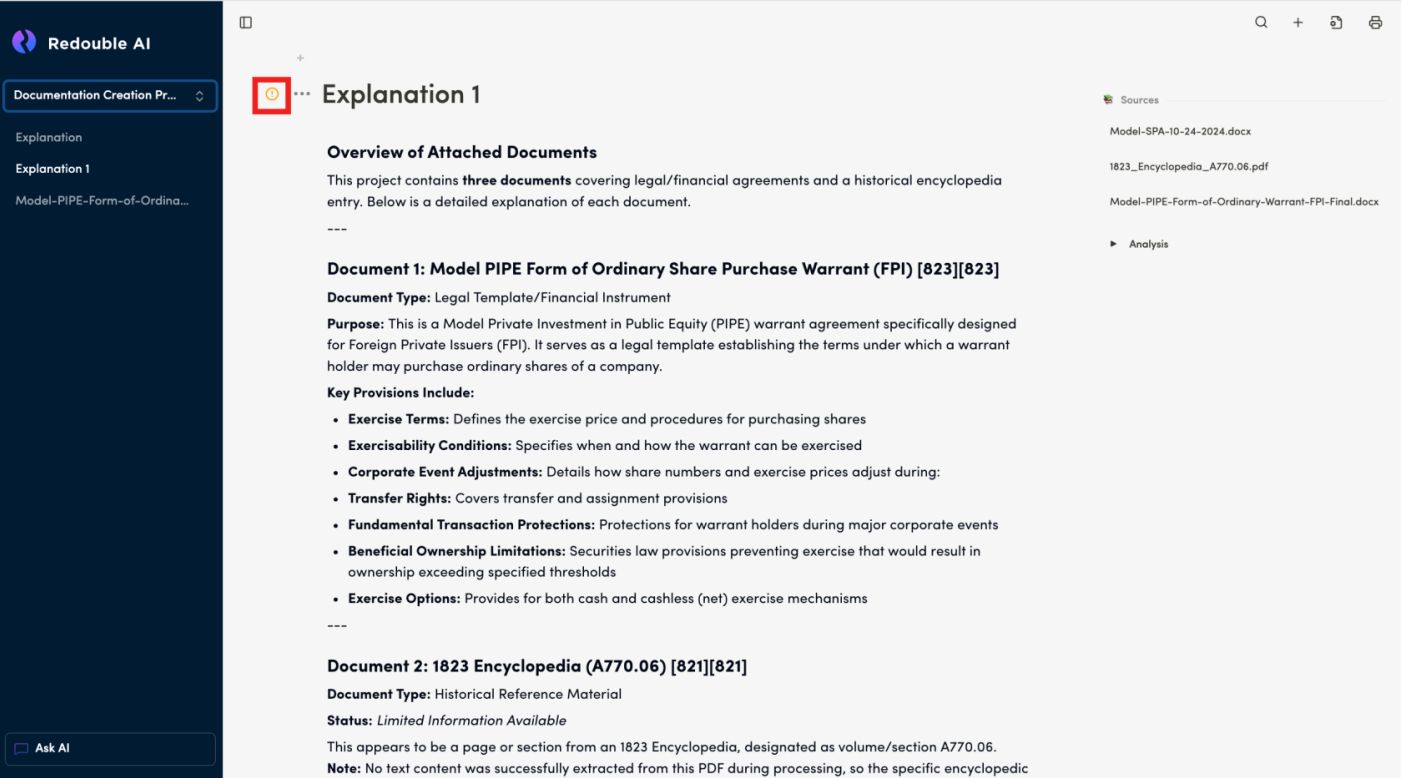
This indicator also appears on questions from a copied project.
